OPEN TO ALL TO COME ATTEND . . .

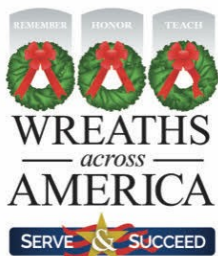
