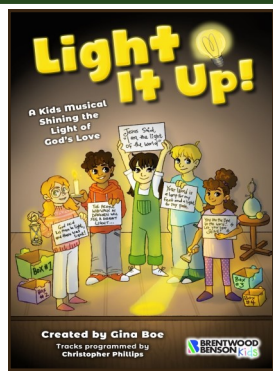

Billy Rader is a Country and Gospel music recording artist and multi-instrumentalist. Billy, along with parents and entire family, were trail blazers and pioneers of providing and promoting clean family entertainment at Panama City Beach, FL.

The Rader family moved to PCB in 1978 from Wichita, Kansas and built a 1,000 seat theater called the Ocean Opry Show on Front Beach Rd. The Rader Family owned and operated the show for 27 consecutive years, performing 200 nights a year.

Billy, a well-seasoned entertainer, has worked with nearly every major Grand Ole Opry artist and Gospel music group in the music industry. His desire and prayer is to be an instrument for the Lord.

Billy's recorded several albums and written many songs. A newly-released Gospel hymn album has been receiving great reviews. Rader will have CDs available for purchase at Gulfview Church on July 21.

We were joined by the group for Sunday Worship Service and two of the youth shared how this trip affected them.

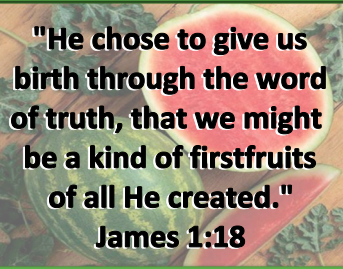
