Our Fellowship Hall will be staging central for two - three hours each day/evening during collection week. We will be looking for a minimum of 5 people to volunteer every day, so consider signing up for a couple of days.

Volunteers at Gulfview will be responsible for accepting boxes, documenting these boxes and then packing them into large cartons. The cartons will need to be transported over to the Central Drop Off location in downtown Panama City on Monday, Nov. 25.

This will be a great time of outreach, welcoming, and presenting our church to the area. Volunteers do not have to be a member at the church, but we are requesting all volunteers attend a training session. A sign up sheet will be in the Fellowship Hall beginning Oct. 20. 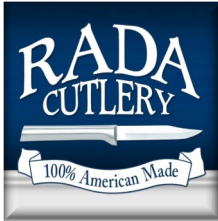

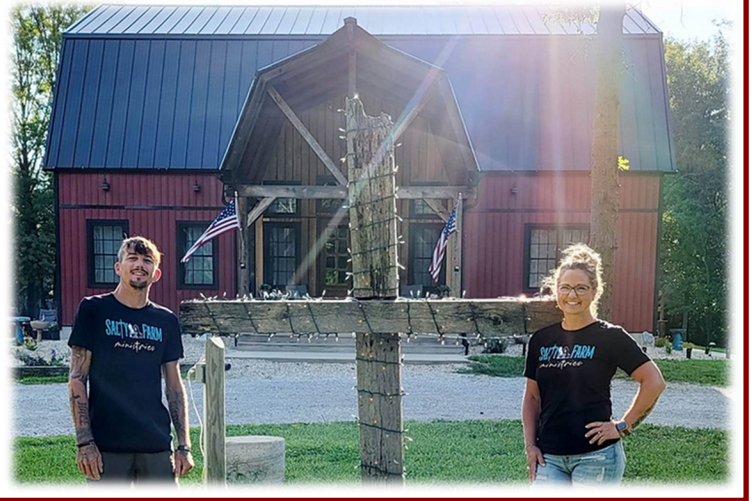
UNITED METHODIST MEN
