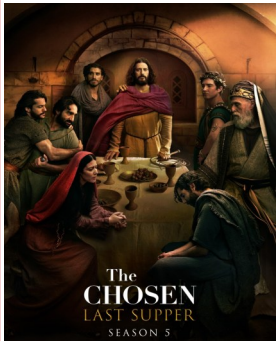

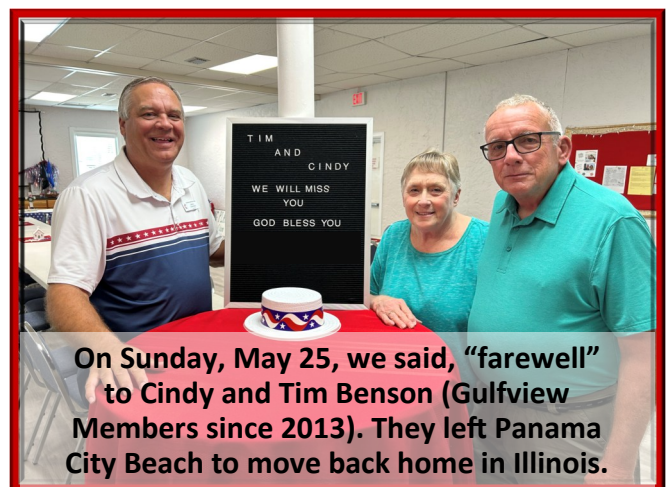
## My Favorite Bible Verse
