- Finance reported a negative cash flow year-to-date of approximately \$3000.
- □ Trustees made a motion to suspend payments of 2025 Apportionments as of September and place in escrow until the lawsuit is resolved. Motion passed.
- Don Hardy will be attending a seminar August 25 in Pensacola regarding possible ways to monetize the church facilities to help with positive cash flow.
- ⇒ Don Hardy, Alternate Lay Delegate to the Annual Conference, presented a video of actions that closed several churches in our Conference on June 10.
- ⇒ Stephen Ministry announced a second training will commence in September.
- ➢ Kerry Gordon, Chair of the Transition Team, reported the team had met and were researching various options should the need arise. Additional team members were suggested.
- ⇒ The final report of the old Visionary Committee was distributed and the resignation of the chair, Dave Raney, was accepted.
- Pastor Brad announced that the Nominations Committee will meet soon to propose a list to be submitted at the 2025 Charge Conference to be held October 12; 5 p.m. at Abide United Methodist Church in Panama City.
- ⇒ The Panhandle District has a new Disaster Coordinator, Scott Gordinio, and a training meeting will be held at Point Washington on September 27.

Trey's Pizza Crust

Ingredients:

2 packages active dry yeast

(not fast acting)

¼ cup olive oil

1 teaspoon salt

4 cups flour

½ cup water



Directions:

Add ½ cup water to bowl; add yeast and whisk until it bubbles.

Wait five minutes.

Add oil, sugar and salt; whisk together.

Add two cups flour and stir.

Add 3rd cup of flour and start to knead with hands.

Add 4th cup of flour; it will get thicker.

Dust counter with flour.

Knead dough 10 – 12 times. Roll in a ball and wrap with plastic wrap.

Rest overnight in refrigerator.

Next Day:

Fold over three or four times.

Put back in fridge.

Dust counter very well.

½ inch – push forward and roll back all the way around.


