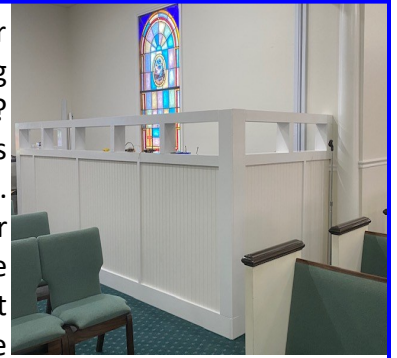

Are you a follower of Jesus?

Some of us grew up going to church from infancy and kept going throughout adulthood. Some of us grew up in church and fell away. And some of us grew up with no church or families of faith but came to know the Lord later in life.

So, what does it mean to be a follower of Jesus? Does being a follower since childhood give you a relationship with Jesus? Does having some knowledge early on but not sticking with it give you a relationship with Jesus? Does having no "religious" background but coming to faith later in life give you a relationship with Jesus?

The Bible verse John 3:16 is known by so many people, those who know Bible verses and those that have never picked up a Bible. That verse is seen on the screens at football games. And sometimes seen by people standing on the side of the street holding a sign.

John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." We just celebrated Easter which is the time when Jesus died on the cross for all our sins and rose again to give us eternal life.

Have you accepted Jesus' invitation of forgiveness and eternal life where your life is forever changed? Or do you celebrate your sins saying, "Oh, I can't help it" . . . "the devil made me do it" . . . "I was born this way." There is some truth to those comments. We were all born sinners. When we realize what Jesus did for us, want to be forgiven and come to Him, it should naturally flow that we should want to pursue changes in our lives to be more like Him.

The ancient Jews would walk so closely behind their rabbi they would be covered in the dust that was kicked up from the rabbi's sandals. This was a visual sign to show that the Jew was following so closely, he saw how the rabbi prayed, studied, gave to the poor etc. It showed how a rabbi's life was an example of someone shaped by the Word of God.

We also should want to be walking so close to Jesus, our rabbi, to become more like Him. Ways to do this are through praying, reading the Bible, studying God's Word, serving, fellowshiping with other believers, etc. So, I leave you with this question to ponder. How dusty are you?
