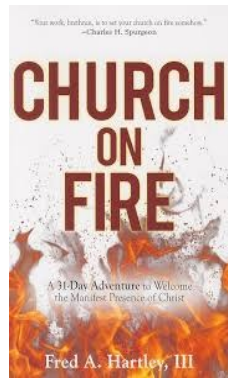

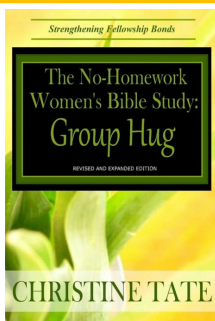
Do you like to pray? The Sanctuary is open every Thursday at 10:30-11 a.m. for anyone to come join in as we lift up prayers for our church.

## CHURCH COUNCIL SUMMARY May 4, 2026

- ▶ Finance Chair Jack Kennedy reported Income through April 30 was \$123,219 and Expenses were \$123,533 including extra expenses for new signs. Council voted to add five Church leaders to the new Trustmark Credit Card with a total limit of \$35,000.
- ▶ Membership Chair Sheila Rucks reported we welcomed 5 new members and lost 11 to total 126.
- ▶ Trustee Chair Steve Berkebile announced they were working with the Veterans 501c3 to combine with God's Closet and provide furniture to vets and community members. He also announced all locks had been rekeyed and new keys given out to Church leadership.
- ▶ Christian Education Chair Jill Zimanek announced a new short study about the Holy Spirit will commence in June. The Ladies Retreat will be in August in Marianna.
- ▶ Congregational Care Chair Sam Blount again requested the anyone needing assistance with meals or transportation for medical emergencies please contact her or Kris in the Church office.
- ▶ Mission Chair Kathy Hardy announced they were supporting a student through Global Effect at \$200/month. Visiting students in June will be helping stuff Blessing Bags.
- ▶ Marketing Chair Don Hardy requested a second financial system be purchased to allow Gulfview to transfer all data from our current system should we have to depart this campus. Motion passed. The Council also voted to order t-shirts with the new name and logo. New signs have been placed over the old UMC signs.
- ▶ The Council voted to participate in the Florida Supreme Court case for an additional \$2,500. The case should take from four to fourteen months.
- ▶ The Council voted to proceed with converting to the updated "One Board" administrative structure by August this year.
- ▶ The Council also voted to proceed with a request to Gulf Beach Presbyterian Church ( Pink Church) to lease their Family Life Building in case we have to leave this campus.

The next meeting will be June 15, 2026 at 4 p.m.
